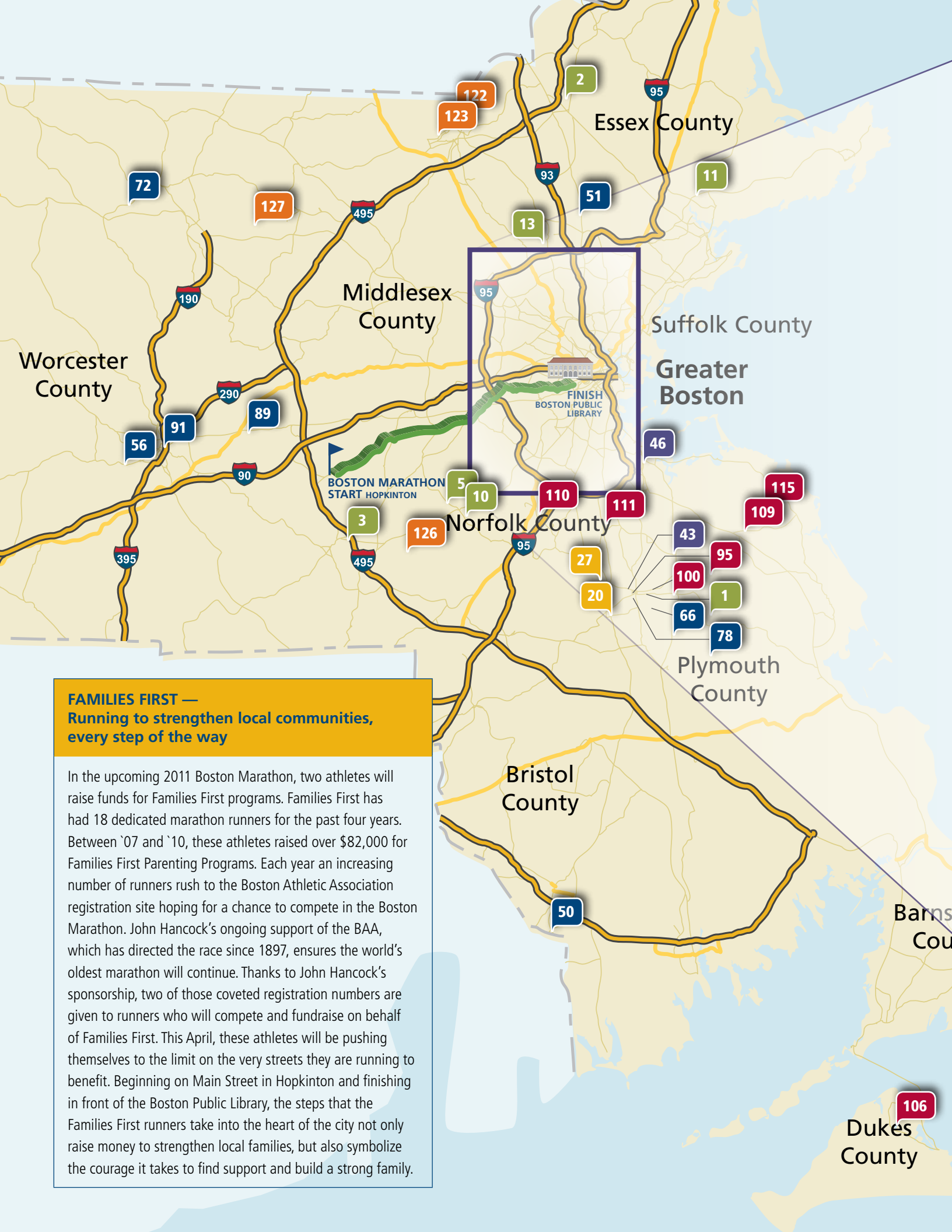


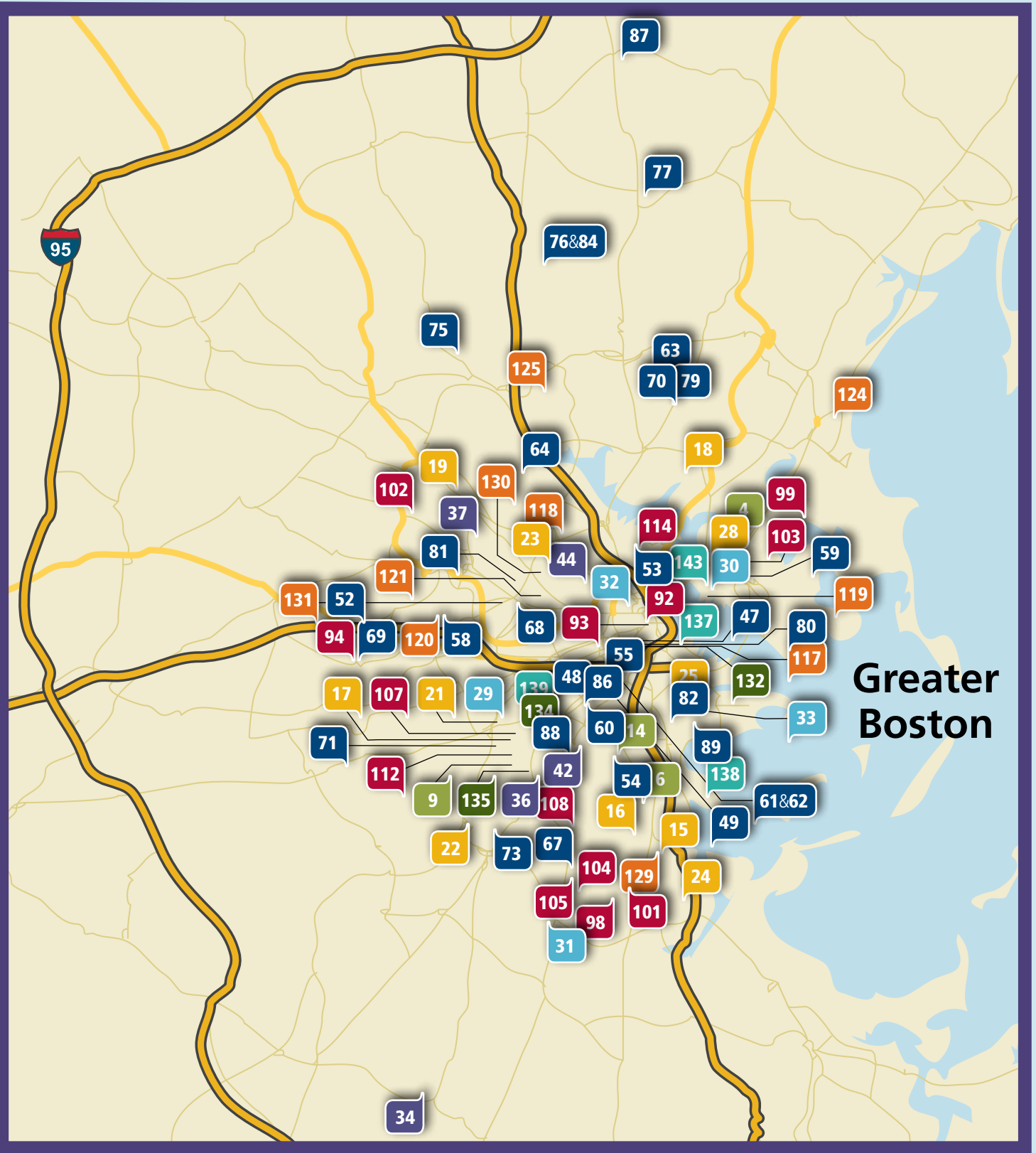


Map of Our Impact in

**FAMILIES FIRST —
Running to strengthen local communities,
every step of the way**

In the upcoming 2011 Boston Marathon, two athletes will raise funds for Families First programs. Families First has had 18 dedicated marathon runners for the past four years. Between '07 and '10, these athletes raised over \$82,000 for Families First Parenting Programs. Each year an increasing number of runners rush to the Boston Athletic Association registration site hoping for a chance to compete in the Boston Marathon. John Hancock's ongoing support of the BAA, which has directed the race since 1897, ensures the world's oldest marathon will continue. Thanks to John Hancock's sponsorship, two of those coveted registration numbers are given to runners who will compete and fundraise on behalf of Families First. This April, these athletes will be pushing themselves to the limit on the very streets they are running to benefit. Beginning on Main Street in Hopkinton and finishing in front of the Boston Public Library, the steps that the Families First runners take into the heart of the city not only raise money to strengthen local families, but also symbolize the courage it takes to find support and build a strong family.
